How long does it take?

All test results are reported within 48 hours from receiving the sample, provided that there is enough sample (>5mL) available by the time the sample reached the lab.

Why is it so important?

- ❖ Screen the patient for unauthorized substances
- ❖ Establish and maintain an optimal does regimen
- ❖ Avoid the risk of prescribing lethal or inappropriate combination of drugs
- ❖ Monitor chronic patients as required by regulatory agencies
